Trading on Bombay Stock Exchange

A guest lecture on the title “Trading on Bombay Stock Exchange” was organised for M.Com First semester students, by PG Department of Commerce, on 12th December 2017. Mrs Marina Jose Kanjikal, presently working as a senior member at BSE was the speaker for the day. Mrs Marina had an immense knowledge of the working of BSE.

Ms Afsana Salam, Faculty PG commerce, introduced the guest to the students. The session was started by Mrs Marina with a brief introduction of her profession as a stock exchange member. Further to make the session effective, the complete session was divided into two parts.
