He shared that **there is no regulation or any ban on the use of cryptocurrencies** in the country. The Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) order banning banks



from supporting crypto transactions, was reversed by the Supreme Court order of March 2020.. In question house session some of the question was raised by the V sem BBA students to know about opportunities and challenges faced by investors in **Cryptocurrency Market**. Finally, the speaker closed the entire deliberation addressing the queries of the audience. There were approximately about 161 participants.
